Dear Members

At the 2016 ASA AGM in July 2016 ASA submitted its ASA Selection Policy and Principles to the ASA Council.

At the ASA QGM in October 2016, Mr Aleck Skhosana, after been re-elected as President of ASA, stated that ASA are now ranked among the top 5 in the world after its success at the 2016 Olympic Games. He stated that to improve on this position at the 2020 Olympic Games will require ASA to work in a 4 year cycle rather the 1-year cycle as the practice was in the past.

On 7 December 2017, ASA announced its 2017-2020 Selection Criteria which will be used to identify and prepare athletes for the 2020 Olympic Games.

With reference to the above, ASA now announce its 1st Squad in preparation for the 2020 Olympic Games. The Senior Squad for the 2020 Olympic Games will be announced soon.

The 2020 ASA Excellence Junior Squad consists primarily of youth and junior athletes and is listed below. The listed athletes were all ranked in the Top 30 in the world in 2016 in their respective events (See IAAF Website).

The progress of the listed athletes will be monitored in 2017. The 1st milestone in the progress of the listed athletes will be the 2017 ASA Youth and Junior Championships in April 2017. After the 2017 ASA Youth and Junior Championships the Squad will be updated, and more athletes may be added to this Squad.

The next milestone for the listed athletes will be the 2017 IAAF World Youth Championships and the 2017 CAA African Junior Championships.

Athletes not listed in the 2020 ASA Excellence Junior Squad listed below, have the right to appeal for reconsideration in writing, to ASA at Hezekiel@athleticssa.co.za; att. Hezekiel Sepeng, before close of business on 14 December 2016. The appeal should include the performance of the athlete and the date/event of the achievement. Athletes without an ASA Permanent License cannot appeal.

Special Notice: It is recommended that Athletes selected in the 2020 ASA Excellence Junior Squad should obtain a South African Passport.
