Dear ASA Members

Circular 4 of ASA 2018 (01/12) – SASA OFFICIAL FEEDER OF ASA PROGRAMMES

1. You are reminded of the arrangement made at the 2017 ASA Annual General Meeting to align the ASA Provincial Constitutions with the ASA Constitution with regards to Associates.

As a direct result, Provinces were requested to accommodate SASA on the Provincial Boards, in the same way SASA serve on the ASA Board as Associate Member.

2. As we are about to enter a new athletics season in 2018, ASA Members are also reminded that SASA now effectively became the official feeder of the ASA capacity building (development) and excellence programmes.

In line with IAAF and ASA Rules and Regulations, SASA events should be listed on either the ASA National or Provincial lists, for the results of such events to be eligible.

3. Furthermore, the IAAF World Youth (U/18) Championships were terminated in 2018, and in future, countries (South Africa included) will rely more on schools to develop excellence skills at youth and sub-youth level.

It is therefore important that, in particular High (Secondary) schools, are exposed to ASA club structures as soon as possible, in other words, High Schools are encouraged to register clubs in the domicile province, or become satellite clubs of existing clubs in the domicile province.

4. ASA is currently in negotiations with both the Departments of Sport, and Department of Education to facilitate and support SASA in its role to be the official feeder of ASA's capacity building and excellence programmes. More information in this regards will follow in due time.
