Dear ASA Members

ASA is one of 8 nations invited to participate in the 2018 Athletics World Cup to be held from 13-15 July in London.

The following teams will be competing for honour (in alphabetical order) **China; France; Jamaica; Germany; Great Britain; Poland; South Africa and United Stars of America.**

South Africa is the only country from the Southern Hemisphere that will participate in the 2018 Athletics World Cup.

Each of the 8 teams will enter a team of men and women consisting of one (1) athlete/team per country. The 17 events that the teams will be competing in, for both men and women, are:

**Track events:** 100m; 200m; 400m; 800m; 1500m; 100mH/110mH; 400mH; 4x100m Relay; 4 x 400m Relay;

**Field Events:** LJ; TJ; SP; DT; JT; HT; PV; HJ

ASA selected a team of 40 athletes (22 men and 18 women) to represent South Africa at the 2018 Athletics World Cup. The team is attached.
