As part of ASA's continues quest for incentivising athletes and coaches to improve the quality of their performances, ASA will be paying incentives to athletes, and their coaches, whom set new ASA records in the senior and junior categories.

Please find attached a list of 14 ASA National records set in official events in 2018.

The athletes and their personal coaches will soon receive incentives for setting new ASA National Records in official events as follows:

Senior Athlete Record incentive: R25 000:00
Junior Athlete Record incentive : R10 000:00
Personal Coach incentive (Junior and Senior): R5 000.00

Members must please note that the ASA National Athletes Committee recommended to the ASA Board, that in view of ASA focus on relays in preparation for the 2020 Olympic Games, that the individual members of relay teams that set new SA records should also be incentivized. This recommendation is still under advisement and members will be notified in due time of the decision.
