ASA CIRCULAR 6 OF 2019

PREPARING FOR THE 2019 CAA AFRICAN YOUTH AND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

Dear ASA Members

With reference to ASA Circular 123 of 2018, ASA announced a Youth and Junior Squad consisting of 61 athletes (31 junior & 30 youth) in preparation for the 2019 CAA African Youth and Junior Champs. The ASA Selection Criteria was used to identify the mentioned squads, based on their performances in 2018.

The 2019 CAA African Youth and Junior Champs already take place in the Ivory Coast from 16 - 20 April 2019. As the 2019 CAA African Youth and Junior Champs takes place so early, the 2019 ASA Youth and Junior Championships will take place from 28 - 30 March 2019.

Effectively this mean that ASA will monitor the results of the 2019 Provincial Youth and Junior Championships and the 2019 SASA High School Championships for selection of a preliminary team for the 2019 CAA African Youth and Junior Champs.

The mentioned team will be finalized during the 2019 ASA Youth and Junior Championships and will be entered for the 2019 CAA African Youth and Junior Champs on 1 April 2019.

To date the following steps were taken to ensure that the potential athletes are ready to represent South Africa successfully:

1. The Youth and Junior Squads were announced in November 2018.
2. The personal Coaches has been kept up to date with relevant information since November 2018
3. The athletes and their personal Coaches by now should be part of the Provincial academy preparation programme
4. ASA already collected the bio-data of the athletes in Nov.-Dec. 2018
5. By now the mentioned athletes should have applied and obtained passports from the closest Internal Affairs office

The way forward is:

1. The mentioned athletes must ensure that they perform well at the competitions mentioned above. Athletes failing to perform at the mentioned events will be removed from the squad.
2. Athletes and coaches should take in mind that over and above the ASA Qualifying Standards, only 2 athletes per event can be entered for the 2019 CAA African Youth and Junior Champs
3. Athletes not listed in the squad below, and achieved the ASA "A"-Standard from October 2018 to March 2019 must appeal via e-mail to ASA for attention Hezekiel Sepeng (hezekiel@athleticssa.co.za) for consideration for the mentioned team.
4. NB: Only results of competitions listed on the ASA national or provincial fixtures will be considered. No other motivations will be considered.
5. Only athletes with passports will be considered for selection of the mentioned team.
