



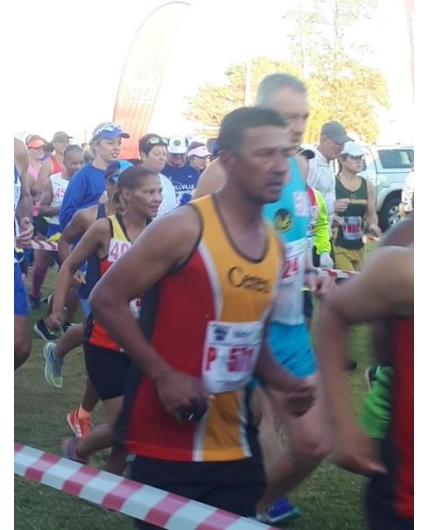

2019 BOLAND ROAD RUNNING LEAGUE 2 RESULTS – SATURDAY 11 MAY 2019

The popular Herfsprag race held at De Doorns on Saturday 11 May was the second Boland League meeting for 2019.

In the 10 km race the talented Ladies Team from Maties had no trouble filling the top positions in the Open- as well as the Junior category. There is just no ending to the talent amongst these ladies with some new names featuring in the results.

In the men's team competition, Ceres now have three teams featuring in the first three positions.

In the 21km competition EGA are back on track with a convincing win in the team competition and filling three positions in the individual competition. Worcester, on home soil, showed that they are a strength to be reckoned with. Their Ladies filled four positions in the individual competition, and the men were second in the team category. Surprisingly, Swartland did not score at all.



After noting the large entries by clubs in the previous League race, it was disappointing to experience the opposite in this event.
