Please find attached the Preliminary Team of 30 athletes that adhere to all the ASA Criteria to be selected for the 2019 IAAF World Championships.

Also listed is a group of 10 Athletes whom have qualified but do not adhere to all the ASA Selection Criteria at this point in time.

A third group of 13 athletes are also listed whom are very close to qualifying for the 2019 IAAF World Championships.

Please note that the marathon team is already in its final preparation for the 2019 IAAF World Championships. The progress of the marathon athletes is monitored by Hendrick Ramaala, the Marathon Team Coach to the 2019 IAAF World Championships.

Please note that 4 x 100m and 4 x 400m men's relay teams have already qualified for the 2019 IAAF World Championships. The progress of the relay teams is monitored by Paul Gorries, the Relay Team Coach to the 2019 IAAF World Championships.

Lastly but most importantly, athletes have time to qualify for the 2019 IAAF World Championships up to, and including, Friday 06 September 2019, where-after the final team to the 2019 IAAF World Championships will be presented to the ASA Board for approval.
