Please find attached the July version of the:

1. SAAS Senior Top 10 Rankings

3. SAAS Youth Top 10 Rankings

With regards to the Senior Top 10 Ranking Lists please note that the top athletes are currently participating internationally. The results of these events are at times challenging to obtain. Athletes and their coaches/representatives must please ensure that the results of these competitions are sent to SAAS asap, as the final team for the 2019 IAAF World Championships will be submitted to the ASA Board for approval during the first week of September 2019.

With regards to the youth and junior Top 10 Ranking Lists, little change took place in this regard. ASA request ASA Members to monitor if the athletes on the ranking lists are registered to the various provincial academies. It is important that the youth and junior athletes, and their coaches remain focused on ASA U/18 (Youth) and U/20 (Junior) T&F Championships scheduled for 4-6 April 2019.

**At the ASA U/18 (Youth) and U/20 (Junior) T&F Championships, a team will be selected to represent South Africa at the 2020 IAAF World Championships from 7-12 May 2020 in Kasarani, Kenya.**

ASA has as objective to echo the achievement of the youth team in 2017 as the no. 1 country on the medal tally of the 2020 IAAF World Championships.

A collective effort from ASA Members, our athletes, their personal coaches and the academies, will result in South Africa achieving the above objective.
